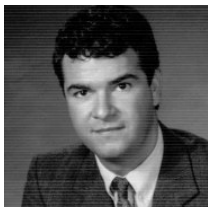

Providing quality repairs comes down to having the experience to know how to do the job right and the determination to ensure that each detail is executed correctly. And that is exactly what we do.

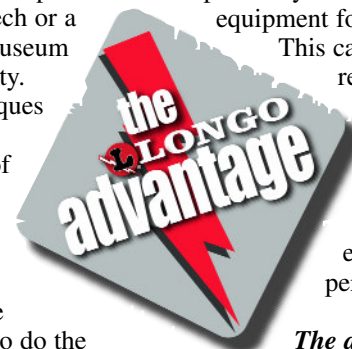

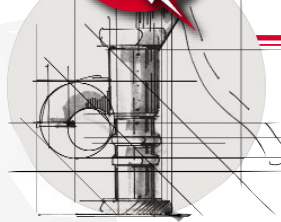

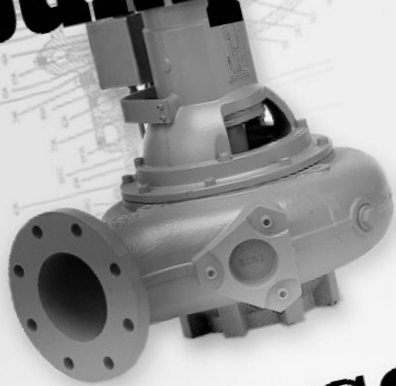
